FourQuarters Recruitment Pty Ltd (ACN 147 881 132) (“**FourQuarters**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”) is committed to protecting your privacy and this policy sets out how we collect and manage your personal information, including personal information collected via <http://www.fourquarters.com.au/> (“**our website**”).

We have created this privacy policy in order to demonstrate our commitment to the *Privacy Act 1988* and the Australian Privacy Principles (together, the “**Australian Privacy Law**”). “**Personal information**” means as defined under the Australian Privacy Law, but generally includes information by which an individual can be identified, and information about an identified individual.

1. What personal information we collect

We may collect and hold the following types of personal information from you: name; age; address; phone number; email address; skills; qualifications; accreditations; employment history; and education history. We may also collect other types of personal information from you such as (but not limited to) communications between us; credit card information; references and employment objectives during the course of dealing with you.

For some positions, you may be required to undertake medical and health checks, and only in these circumstances will we collect “sensitive information” from you.

2. How we collect your personal information

We collect personal information from you in a variety of ways, including when you interact with us electronically, over the phone or in person, when we provide our services to you or for you, when we receive results of your medical and health tests, when we conduct reference and/or police checks, and when you use our website.

If we receive personal information about you from third parties, we will protect it as set out in this Privacy Policy.

3. Use of your personal information

Main purposes for using your personal information

We need your personal information to provide you with our services, including assessing whether or not you are a suitable candidate for a role with our clients, and placing you in suitable roles.

We may also use your personal information (directly or through an agent) to verify your qualifications, work rights and identity, conduct reference checks, assess your suitability to work in a particular job or work environment, provide information about our services to you and to our clients, create and update our databases, ensure compliance with our contractual and other legal obligations to you, manage our website, and administer our relationship with you by responding to your enquiries (“**Main Purposes**”).

If you do not provide us with your personal information, we may not be able to carry out or fulfil some or all of the Main Purposes.

Additional uses of your personal information

We may also use your personal information to provide you with information, updates and our services other than in connection with our Main Purposes. We also use it to improve our services and our website and to notify you of opportunities that we think you might be interested in. We may use your personal information to improve our products and services and better understand your needs. We may also use your personal information:

- for any purpose disclosed to you in an information collection statement at the point where we collect your personal information; or
- for a purpose related to one of the Main Purposes.

We may contact you by a variety of measures including, but not limited to telephone, email, SMS or mail.

4. Disclosure of your personal information

We may disclose your personal information to third parties, and by providing personal information to us you consent to us disclosing that information as follows:

- We may disclose your personal information and (in some cases) sensitive information to any of our employees, officers, insurers, professional advisers, agents, suppliers, subcontractors, potential and actual employers and clients, your nominated referees, education providers (to verify your qualifications), former employers (to verify your employment history and suitability for certain roles), workers compensation bodies, government department or bodies, doctors and other medical service providers, and any designated and registered training provider, insofar as is reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy. Personal information is only supplied to a third party when it is required for the delivery of our services.
- We may from time to time need to disclose personal information to comply with a legal requirement, such as a law, regulation, court order, subpoena, warrant, in the course of a legal proceeding or in response to a law enforcement agency request.
- We may also use your personal information to protect the copyright, trademarks, legal rights, property or safety of FourQuarters, <http://www.fourquarters.com.au/>, its clients or third parties.
- Information that we collect may from time to time may be stored, processed in, or transferred between parties located in countries outside of Australia. We may store your Personal Information in locations outside the direct control of FourQuarters, for instance, on servers or databases co-located with hosting providers.
- If there is a change of control in our business or a sale or transfer of business assets, we reserve the right to transfer to the extent permissible at law our user databases, together with any personal information and non-personal information contained in those databases. This information may be disclosed to a potential purchaser under an agreement to maintain confidentiality. We would seek to only disclose information in good faith and where required by any of the above circumstances.

By providing us with personal information, you consent to the terms of this Privacy Policy and the types of disclosure covered by this Policy. Where we disclose your personal information to third parties, we will request that the third party follow this Policy regarding handling your personal information.

5. Security of your personal information

We are committed to ensuring that the information you provide to us is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure information and protect it from misuse, interference, loss and unauthorised access, modification and disclosure.

The transmission and exchange of information is carried out at your own risk. We cannot guarantee the security of any information that you transmit to us, or receive from us. Although we take measures to safeguard against unauthorised disclosures of information, we cannot assure you that personal information that we collect will not be disclosed in a manner that is inconsistent with this Privacy Policy. We are not liable for any unauthorised access to this information.

6. Access to your personal information

You are solely responsible for ensuring that your personal information is accurate, current, and complete. You may request details of personal information that we hold about you in accordance with the provisions of Australian Privacy Law. A small administrative fee may be payable for the provision of information.

If you would like a copy of the information which we hold about you or believe that any information we hold on you is inaccurate, out of date, incomplete, irrelevant or misleading, please email us at admin@fourquarters.com.au. For your protection, we may require you to confirm your identity before access to your personal information is granted.

You may opt out of any future contact from us at any time. You may also ask us to change, correct, destroy, or return any of your personal information that we hold. We reserve the right to refuse to provide you with information that we hold about you, in certain circumstances set out in the Privacy Act.

7. Anonymity

You have the right to request to remain anonymous in any dealings or communications you may have with us, but we may not be able to provide you with services on that basis.

8. Complaints and Queries

10. Other information
